## Featuring: **SAM ABELL**

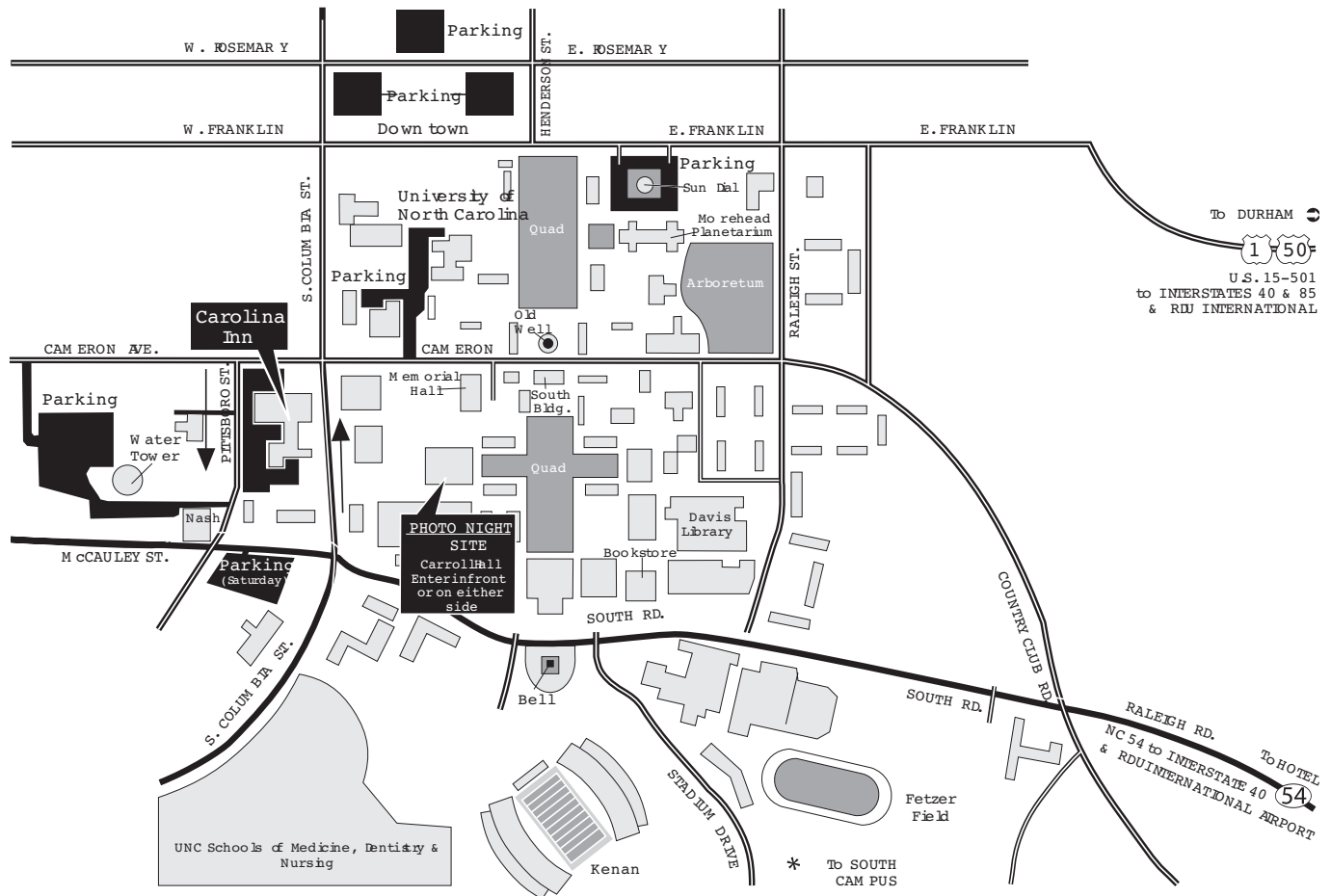
